NEP-2020 (FYUGP) Under Graduate Course for the Session 2026-27

About NEP-2020 (FYUGP)

A **Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP)** with multiple entries and exits. In this programme, one has the choice to exit from the programme thrice – after one year, after two years and after three years.

PROGRESSION

In FYUGP, students get a Bachelor Degree with Major after 3 years and a degree with Major & Honours or a degree with Honours with Research after 4 years. If a student exits the FYUGP after 3 years, she/he will need to take admission into the first year of a Master's programme, which is a 2-year Master degree programme. However, if a student fully completes an FYUGP, she/he needs to take admission into the second year of a Master's programme and needs to complete only one year to get a Master Degree. Once a student takes admission into a Master's programme either after 3 years of the Bachelor's programme or after FYUGP, one will be able to take admission into a Doctoral programme leading to the Degree of PhD. However, if a student is exceptionally good, one can directly take admission into a Doctoral programme right after the FYUGP, by passing the Master's programme.

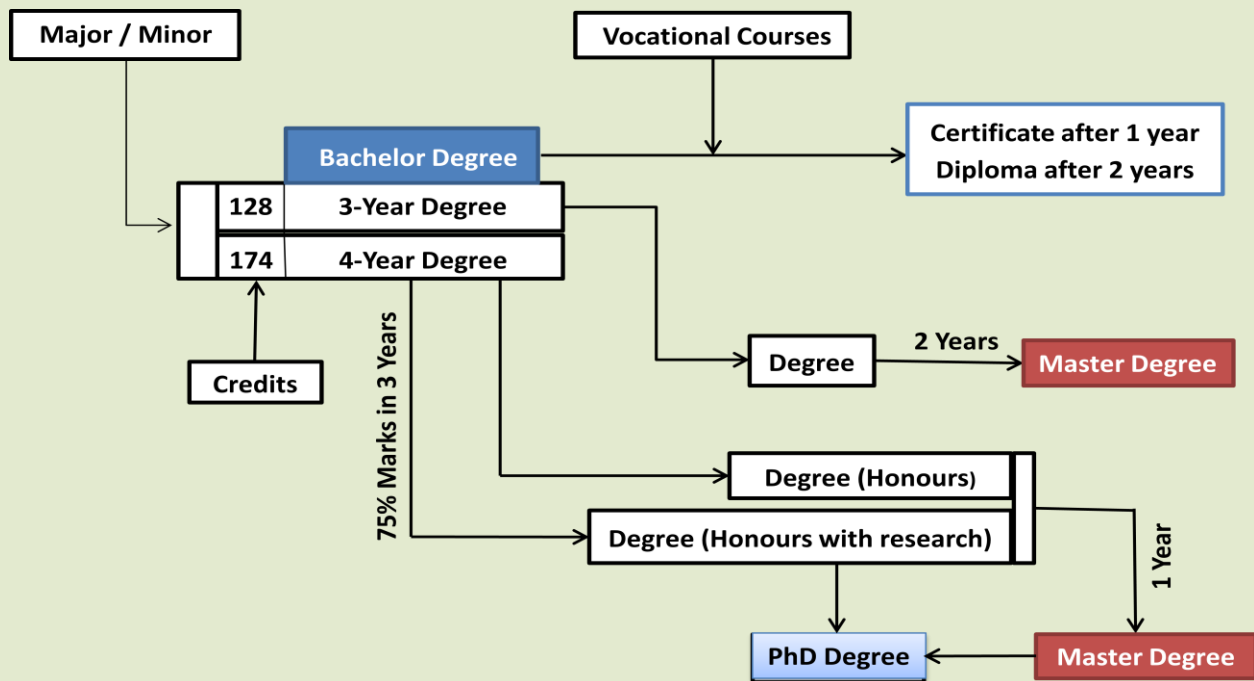


Figure: Progression under FYUGP (Madhabdev University)



OUR COURSES

Basically, there are two parts of a course under the FYUGP – (a) Core Courses and (b) Common Courses. As the name suggests, different students study different core courses and all students study the common courses. The minimum credit allocation for a 3-year programme is **66** credits in Core Courses and 62 credits in Common Courses, which comes to a total of minimum **128** credits for a 3-year programme. With the fourth year, the minimum credit requirement becomes **174**.

CORE COURSES

The Core Courses determine the ultimate degree, diploma, or certificate a student will earn at the end of third (or fourth) year, second year, or first year, respectively. The Core Courses have to be chosen among a plethora of subjects offered for both the types of degrees, respectively. In case of a Bachelor's Degree in a Stream, the components of the Core Courses are Major and / or Minors. Usually, for majority of the students, the Core Course will consist of one Major and one Minor.

COMMON COURSES

The common courses are to be studied by all students alike and all-together they carry total credits of 34 over a 3-year period. These courses are further divided into following sub-categories:

Multi-disciplinary Course (MDC): These are 3-credit courses spanning over different groups of subjects.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC): An Ability Enhancement Course is aimed at providing the student with skill and ability. The Ability Enhancement Courses must be opted by a student and the student can choose papers from a pool of Skill Enhancement Courses. This is an 8-credit course in total covering Language/ Alternative English and English Usage (Communication).

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC): These are various skill courses with total credit allocation of 10. All students need to complete three skill courses during Semesters 1-3.

Value Added Course (VAC): The VAC courses will come from various sub groups comprises of Introduction to Yoga, NSS & Youth development, Sports & Physical Education, Primary skills on Rover & Ranger and Environmental Studies. All together they will have a credit allocation of 7. Each student will have to take any three courses from any three groups during Semesters 1, 2, & 3.

Internship: All students are to carry out an internship with a credit allocation of 4. The internship is expected to be carried out in Semester 4 & 5. The internships are meant to be done during semester breaks they will not interfere with other classes.

Research Project: A student can opt (Subject to conditions) a dissertation or a project work of 2 credits in the Sixth Semester.

THE FOURTH YEAR

In the FYUGP, the fourth year is at par with the first year of a Master's programme, as a student can directly take admission into the second year of a Master's programme after the successful completion of the FYUGP. In the fourth year, a student has to complete one compulsory paper on Research Methodology (REM) in the Semester 7, which is a 4-credit theory paper. The rest of courses will consist of Advanced Core Courses and a Dissertation depending on whether a student opts for a Degree (Honours) or Degree (Honours) with Research.

Instructions

- ❖ Students of Major course will have to select only one Minor subject.
- ❖ Students of Major course will have to select subjects from AEC, MDC, SEC and VAC in the respective semesters as given in the curriculum.
- ❖ Selection of applicants will be made as per merit.
- ❖ A student desirous of offering a subject as Major Course must secure at least 50% marks in the concerned subject in HS level. The subject selection will be made on merit basis only.
- ❖ Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD applicant will be maintained as per Govt. rules.
- ❖ Subject choose at the time of Admission cannot be changed afterwards.

Examination and Evaluation

- ❖ A candidate has to secure at least 40% of total marks in each paper (Internal assessment + End semester marks), provided he/she has to secure not less than 30% marks in the end semester examination.
- ❖ If a candidate fails in a subject either theory or practical, he/she has to repeat the papers by attending all the classes and by appearing for internal as well as external examinations at the next opportunity.
- ❖ A student who fails in the last semester examination shall be declared as Not Completed the Lower Semester Examination (NCL). Such candidates shall be eligible for the degree only after completion of all the NCL.
- ❖ Internal Assessment marks will be 40% of a paper. The details of Internal Assessment are given below.

- ❖ Information regarding fees Structure will be notified in the College website before Admission dated as per latest Govt. Guidelines.
- ❖ Entire admission process will be conducted on-line for the academic session 2026-27 through **Samarth portal**.
- ❖ Students have to upload scanned copies of Mark sheets, Certificates and all other relevant documents for the admission process. Authenticity of uploaded documents will be verified by college authority if needed.
- ❖ Students have to upload bank details including IFSC Code, Bank Name and Branch, mobile number and email id to avail the benefit of any type of applicable govt. schemes.

Important instructions

- ❖ Candidates desirous to take admission are asked to download the Prospectus from the college website and follow the instructions before filling up the application form.
- ❖ Candidates desirous to take admission in UG courses (B.A. & B. Sc. 1st Semester) have to register their name in the UG admission portal 'SAMARTH' (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/index.php>).
- ❖ Registration and profile completion has to be done in the first phase. The necessary documents have to be uploaded in this process. The second phase of the admission includes form fill-up process and college selection part.
- ❖ Students can avail the Fee Waiver Scheme of Govt. of Assam as per the terms and conditions of the scheme. For detail guidelines of the Fee Waiver Scheme visit the college website.
- ❖ Fee Structure for admission into B.A. & B. Sc. 1st Semester will be uploaded in the college website.
- ❖ Candidates have to choose subjects as per subject groups from the instructions given in the Prospectus.
- ❖ Applications with incomplete documents and information will be summarily rejected by the admission committee.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO BE NOTED

- Admission for FYUGP (Four-year Undergraduate Programme), FYIMP (Five-year Integrated Master Programme) and FYIPGP (Five-year Integrated Post Graduate Programme) either through non-CUET mode or CUET mode, 4 will be provisioned only through the common admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) for all Govt/ Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Adarsha Mahavidyalaya/ Provincialized/ Govt. Model Colleges/Autonomous Colleges. Additionally, admissions for FYIMP and FYUGP in State University Campuses and Participating Private/Venture/Non-Government Colleges affiliated with State Universities and Assam University will also be provisioned only through the common admission portal. (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>)
- Students will get six (6) options for programme selection either in the same Higher Educational Institution (University/Colleges) or in different Higher Educational Institutions (HEI) (University/Colleges).
- Students need to mark preferences against the options of programmes. HEIs will be indicated of the preference given by the applicants. Autonomous Colleges/Universities shall prepare the merit lists in accordance with their admission rules. However, affiliated colleges shall prepare their merit list in accordance to the relevant policy of the concerned Affiliating Universities.
- HEIs will have to do the academic scrutiny (selection of papers based on eligibility for the programme/discipline) or verified marks after entering SAMARTH from number/CUET registration numbers.
- After Academic Scrutiny, the HEIs will mark the students considered for offering admission by processing the merit list in the admission portal itself. Once marked and saved by the HEI, the merit list for the programs can be generated and visible to students in the "merit list section" of the admission portal (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/>) after the lists are published in the admission.



6. The students will receive an admission offer message with a URL in their registered email and mobile number for further processing. Only upon acceptance of the admission offer by the applicant by logging into their admission portal, the Universities or colleges will be able to process the application for grant of admission.
7. In the subsequent merit lists, if an admitted student is offered admission in a program/college in a relatively higher order of their preference, and if they wish to take admission in their HEI then they need to raise a cancellation request on the first day of publication of the subsequent merit list till 5 PM and the cancellation request will be automatically approved, so that the applicant may take admission easily. The fee will be refunded automatically, provided they make the payment through the integrated Payment Gateway. In case the student has made the payment in cash then they need to collect the refund from the institution itself.
8. The total numbers of students in the Merit list against each programme and discipline will be strictly as per the sanctioned seat matrix for the Major Programme in that discipline. In the case of Discipline Specific programs, the Merit list against that discipline-specific programme will be as per the sanctioned seat matrix for that discipline-specific programme. Once admission is offered by the College/University to the candidates, it is mandatory for the HEIs to give admission to the candidates subject to document scrutiny and in compliance with College/University polices, as applicable.
9. Waiting lists may be published by respective HEIs if they desire to do so. However, this is optional and if the students who appear in the waiting lists are not subsequently added in the next merit list, then the Department of Higher Education nor the SAMARTH team will be responsible.
10. Colleges and Universities will have the discretion to check and verify the income certificates produced by applicants at the time of admission. In case of any doubt, the institution may ask the candidate to produce further relevant documents to ascertain the validity of the claim regarding the status of income below 4 lakhs, and only after being fully satisfied with the authenticity of the claim, they are to be granted admission under the Fee Waiver category. If the Institution is unsatisfied with the claim, they need to inform the applicant in writing with justification and grant admission under the non-fee waiver category.
11. HEIs will be able to view their Fee status (received either through Cash or Payment gateway) and the net amount (admission minus cancellation) shall be remitted to the HEI's account upon completion of the cycle of admission 2026-27.
12. Transparency in admissions shall be ensured, including obtaining proper consent from students. Retention of original mark sheets or certificates by any institution is strictly prohibited.

ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION

- The students must have at least 75% attendance in lectures delivered in each of the subjects opted by them.
- Students are required to obtain the qualifying mark in aggregate of all subjects in the Sessional Examination.
- Leave must be applied in advance duly countersigned by parents/ guardian.
- In case of serious illness, the leave application must be submitted within a week along with Medical Certificate. 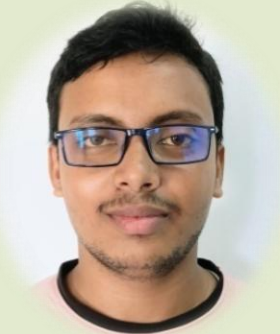

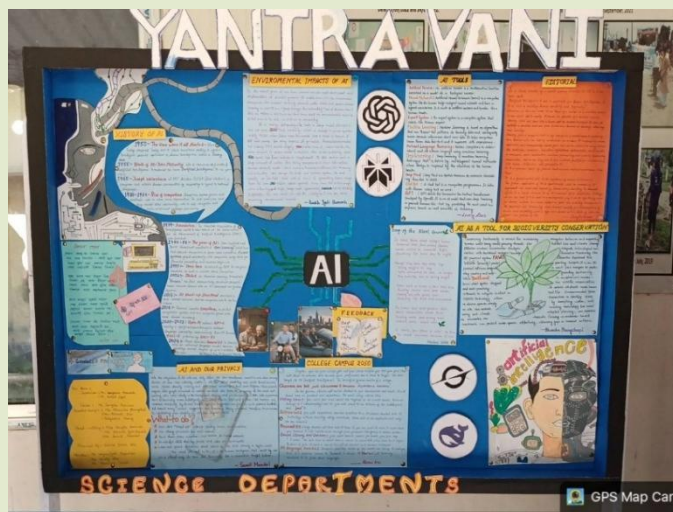
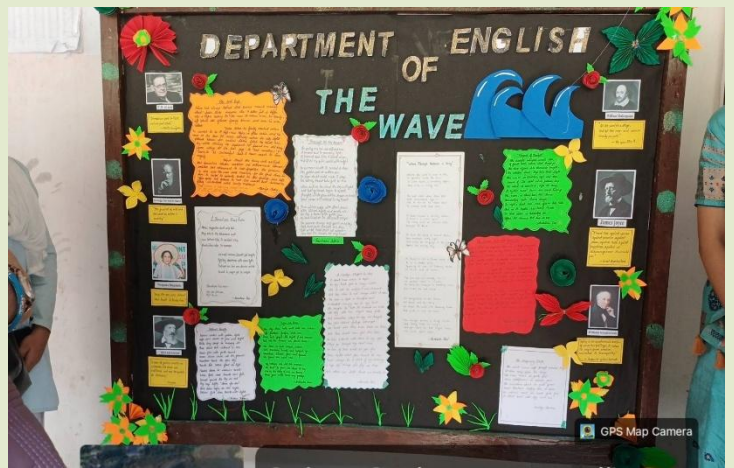
